About the Eternal Flame

The Eternal Flame is the second element of the Acadian Memorial to be installed. Its source of fuel is Louisiana natural gas fed through a mechanism equipped with an electric sensor designed to restart the flame should it accidently be extinguished. The flame rises through the center of a polished granite oval. Its surface is inscribed with the outline of the Atlantic rim and marked with the major settlement sites of the Acadian refugees. Text on the apron reads: UN PEUPLE SANS PASSE' EST UN PEUPLE SANS FUTUR --A PEOPLE WITHOUT A PAST IS A PEOPLE WITHOUT A FUTURE. A mission of the Acadian Memorial is to affirm the past and in so doing, assure the future.

As the element of fire is traditional in the rituals of the Catholic Church, so the Eternal Flame represents the deep attachment of the Acadian exiles to their religion. Additionally, it burns in memory of all exiles, the unwanted and the outcast, and, through the constancy of its flame symbolizes the ability of a culture to rekindle itself despite immense hardship.
